1. BI Team – HANA ULO Status

It was announced that there is a plan to retire BI ULO within the next thirty days. If additional time is needed, please contact Customer Service and it will be considered.

- a. WCF requested date of BI ULO retirement? WFC requires to use of BI ULO to prevent having to pull 5 separate reports. There is no set date but will bring their concerns to Tiffany and the team.
- b. FS asked if there is an update on the Period of Performance for IAS docs in HANA ULO? Yes. Period of Performance for IAS related document was implemented on last Friday, April 12th.

2. Security –

3. Open Discussion –

FMMI Payroll Processing – NFC will produce retro pay in pay period 07. They are anticipating a large volume of data to increase up to 13X normal volume and this could cause a problem for backend processes like BI.

- a. The plan is, once the payroll splitter completes Saturday morning FMS will assess the data volume and may have to process into FMMI in multiple steps by Agency.
- b. Schedule will be set by Monday morning and Agencies not processed over the weekend will be notified.
- c. This may impact the payroll accrual run for next weekend. FMS will have a better understanding of the true impact by Monday and Agencies will be notified if the accrual schedule changes.
